**Conference to commemorate the 50th anniversary of the founding assembly of
the International Association of Catalan Language and Literature (AILLC);
Fitzwilliam College - Universitat de Cambridge (197**

The year 2023 will mark the 50th anniversary of the founding assembly of the International Association of Catalan Language and Literature (AILLC), which was held at Fitzwilliam College, University of Cambridge, in 1973. To mark the event, a commemorative academic conference will be held at the college on Saturday 15th July 2023. The aim of this event is to reflect on the progress of Catalan studies during the last fifty years, with the contributions from, among others, some of the original participants of the 1973 colloquium. The conference will also honour the role of Fitzwilliam College, a constant reference in the teaching and research of Catalan culture in the British university context since 1967.

During the conference, six renowned international specialists in the field of Catalan studies will present an overall perspective of their respective research areas. The confirmed speakers include: Gemma Rigau and Joan Veny, in the area of Catalan language; and Rosa Cabré i Monné, Dominic Keown and Joan Lluís Marfany, in the field of Catalan literature.

Call for research posters

The event program will include a poster presentation session open to researchers in Catalan language and literature. Those interested in presenting their research should send a proposal for a poster (in Catalan or English) to the following address: aillc.cambridge2023@gmail.com before 12:00 (Catalan time) on Wednesday 1st February 2023. The maximum length of a poster proposal should be one page of A4, 12-point, 1.5 line-space, with 2.5 cm margins. References, examples, and/or figures can be included on a second page.

Accommodation and travel grants

The AILLC is offering five grants of up to 300 euros each for travel and accommodation expenses.

Successful applicants will:

- Be a Master's or PhD student.
- Be under 30 years of age.
- Be a member of the AILLC (up to date with the payment of annual fees).
- Have had a poster accepted at the conference.

Documents to be submitted:

- An email containing the first name, surname, date of birth, postal address, email address, and telephone number of the applicant.
- A document signed by the director of the department/centre at which the applicant is enrolled. The applicant MUST confirm: that they are a student, the studies that they are following, and whether or not they have a pre-doctoral scholarship.
- The applicant's CV.

Document submission and deadline:

Applications for grants must be sent by email before Wednesday 1st February 2023 to the address: aillc@iec.cat; email subject: "Borsa_AILLC Cambridge 2023".

Commitment: In accepting the grant, the recipients commit themselves to present their poster and to attend all of the conference sessions, and to submit the original invoices corresponding to the expenses incurred for the amount awarded to a maximum of 300 euros. The selected candidates will be contacted via email before Wednesday 15th March 2023. The amount awarded will be transferred after the conference, once the recipients are able to prove attendance.

Registration, accommodation and formal commemorative dinner

Registration: the event is free, but to attend (and book accommodation and tickets for the commemorative formal dinner) the following form must be filled in before Saturday 1st April 2023.

Since accommodation is limited, we will confirm accommodation reservations from Saturday 1st April 2023 onwards and provide instructions in order for attendees to make their payments (dinner / accommodation+dinner).

Accommodation: Participants who wish to do so will be able to stay in single rooms at Fitzwilliam College on the nights of Friday 14th and Saturday 15th July 2023 (limited places, allocated on a first-come, first-served basis). Price per night: Single room + breakfast: 90 euros.

Formal dinner: Participants will be able to attend the formal dinner taking place at Fitzwilliam College on the evening of Saturday 15th July. Price: 45 euros.

Wednesday 1st February 2023: deadline for the submission of applications for accommodation and travel grants.

Saturday 1st April 2023: deadline for registration.
